
Initial Study Goals

- Understand baseline conditions to establish historical context.
- Gain an understanding of trends that will impact future use and suggest management strategies.
- Develop and seek input from engaged stakeholders regarding desired conditions for the Lower Delaware Wild and Scenic River.
- Seek public input to advise the development of 'desired conditions' through a town hall-style, virtual public meeting.
- Recommend management strategies and tactics to achieve desired conditions based on input received from Fall 2020 input.
- Develop an in-person interview program to conduct at river launch sites.







Opinion of recreational use growth on the Lower Delaware WSR?




Contributors to Growth of Recreation




Other reasons for the river's popularity






Positive Impacts of Popularity





Non-Positive Impacts of Popularity



Challenge: promote and manage access



Seek public input on the development of 'desired conditions'





Suggested LDWSR MC composition to balance goals


Conduct period stakeholder meetings for input.

Require representatives to serve on Council.

Develop a management plan to which representatives contribute.

Invite representatives to serve on Council.

Ask reps of both groups to develop a balancing process.





Partnership Strategies

Leverage user group self-interest in management discussions:

- Jurisdictions
- Agencies managing launch access
- Boating law administrators
- Business owners
- Private landowner representatives
- Non-profit group leaders

Identify 'wins' when all have skin in the game.







Actions

- Invite conversations to advise the Council
- Invite resource agencies to invite volunteer assistance
- ▶ Inventory, coordinate outreach among extended LDWSR partners (phone tree)
- Galvanize, share leadership with reach-wide initiatives
- Reach out to non-participant jurisdictions
- Develop a management plan to address capacity
- Survey tool to 'count' users will help develop baseline
