 - Upper Mt. Bethel River Pointe Logistics- <u>lawsuit</u> seeking to halt Upper Mount Bethel Township officials' plan to dissolve a sewer authority. Suit filed against the five-member township supervisor board and engineer
 - Paunnacussing gas line and Aqueduct Sarah
 - The Lumberville Aqueduct is in removal process. NPS (Wild and Scenic, and National Historic Landmark team) had to be consulted about some changes in design. But all of the approvals have been made and that one is well underway.

- High Falls is in the design stages. Met onsite with the two NPS teams, the PA State Historic Preservation team (SHPO), FEMA, and the PA DCNR because the removal of the old, failed, existing culvert structure officially makes it an 'adverse impact' in terms of historical context. (This is not under Wild and Scenic, but under the Nat'l Historic Landmark and FEMA auspices). So to manage the 'adverse impact' finding, alternatives need to be considered, the team needs to agree on the best alternative, and then there need to be accommodations for documenting the history, etc. –Sarah
- Rockfall mitigation Stephen, Richard, Tara
 - Devil's Tea Table- July meeting to be scheduled
 - 1. Change the safety bar-NPS to meet with FHWA to see if this can be required by FHWA as a condition of federal funding.
 - 2. Options such as just monitoring the road, changing the speed limit on the road and expanding the ditch were written off for reasons that there is nowhere to station a police car, the expanded ditch does solve the problem, and just monitoring is not considered an option.
 - 3. NJDOT offered up a lower impact option that they still need to investigate involving moving the road, but they stated that this might have other impacts on the canal towpath and other natural resources (trees). This is more impactful to other resources because they are refusing to lower the 95% criteria. If they lower to 90%, it will likely be less impactful on other resources.
